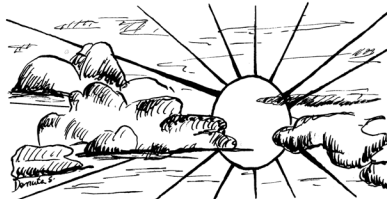

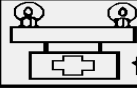


LA TEMPORADA DE GRIPE
