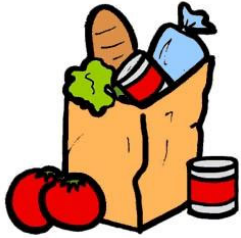

Our CCD Fall Service Project has started! All CCD classes are to collect canned goods for Heart to Heart until December 5th. The classroom that collects the most



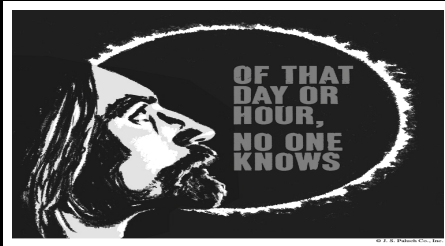

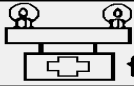
THE GIVING TREE 2018 will start November 25th—December 10th.
